EKAM Indianapolis Highlights 2023

Initiatives in India

In 2023 our major focus has been in the areas of early childhood development, adolescent education, basic healthcare needs, and enablina livelihood in Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana and Jharkhand. To this end we have completed several projects, either chapter specific or as part of National service projects. These include Anganwadi support, basic infrastructure for PHCs, vision care for school kids, cataract surgeries, custom made-prosthetics, bicycles for girl students, blankets, personal hygiene kits for cerebral palsy patients, livelihood support for widows, and more!

Anganwadis

Funded basic needs like weighing scales, educational and play materials for 132 anganwadis in Madurai, Salem and Chennai, helping over 3000 kids



Vision Care Camps & Cataract Surgeries

Recognizing that early intervention is the most costeffective way to address vision issues in children, we partnered with Ekam Foundation to fund screening camps for 700 school children in Madurai & follow-up care for 29 kids needing prescription glasses. Supported 20 cataract surgeries in AP & Punjab.



Bicycles & Toilets for Girl Students

To facilitate transportation from remote rural areas, w funded bicycle banks with 43 bicycles in Sanikavaran and Bommalapuram schools in Andhra Pradesh. Funded functional toilet block for girls in LKB Nagar School. Madurai.



Basic Infrastructure for PHCs

Supported 3 PHCs in Madurai with life saving equipment like a fetal doppler and an infant warmer & basic needs such as BP apparatuses, x-ray supplies, and an RO unit.



Prosthetic Limbs

We funded over 100 custom prosthetic limbs for beneficiaries in Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and Telangana.

Ducklings for Widows


For livelihood support, donated ducklings, feed and medicine to 10 widows who lost their husbands to COVID, in Jharkhand.

Local volunteering

Horizon House

Ekam Indy families have donated supplies and made 375 snack bags, and 667 sandwiches for unhoused neighbors who use the facilty as a day shelter. We also donated \$500 leveraging Value Circle matching funds.



Gleaners and Midwest Food Banks of Indiana
