

# Education - \$74,897 project budget, 1700+ beneficiaries impacted

EKAM USA supported education and student welfare through grants, college fee assistance, and tutoring programs, while also providing school resources such as bicycles, notebooks, solar panels, and sanitary facilities to improve access, learning, and hygiene for underprivileged children and youth in India.



# Community Empowerment = \$63,433 raised and ~4000 beneficiaries impacted

EKAM USA supported livelihood development through vocational training, small businesses, and equipment, while also strengthening communities with nutrition projects, clean water, healthcare, shelter, and support for vulnerable groups, along with environmental initiatives like tree planting.





# 2024 Project Highlights

## Health = \$67,126 raised and 5700+ beneficiaries impacted

EKAM USA supported a wide range of health and humanitarian initiatives, including providing prosthetic limbs, hemophilia medical bracelets, medical kits and equipment for patients, support for hospitals and spinal cord injury care, clean water through RO plants, aid to orphanages and hospices, and assistance to vulnerable children and families across different regions of India.



# Disaster Relief= \$18,358 raised and 2300+ beneficiaries impacted

EKAM USA supported disaster relief efforts, including providing aid and resources for flood-affected communities in Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh.





## **Clothing Drive**

Organized a successful clothing drive in partnership with Savers in May of 2024 to support local families in need. Volunteers (Anushka, Arshea, Trisha, Aditya, Janvhi, Saathvika, Lasya, and Sowmya) collected and sorted gently used clothing, household goods, and books. They ended up collecting over 3100 lbs of soft goods and 259 lbs of hard goods.





### **Blanket and Beanie Donations**







In both January and December of 2024, volunteers organized a Winter Blanket and Beanie Drive to help those in need stay warm during the colder months. Led by EKAM Youth Ambassadors—Anushka, Aditya, Varshaa, Anika, Arshea, Saathvika, and Trisha—the team handmade and donated 80 beanies and 60 blankets to shelters and community centers, including First Presbyterian Church and Tri-Valley Haven.

### Meals on Wheels Cards Initiatives







Throughout 2024, the Bay Area chapter of EKAM USA Savers carried out a year-long Card Drive to bring smiles and encouragement to homebound seniors. With donations made in February, March, August, and December, the team created and delivered over 400 handmade cards to Meals on Wheels, spreading warmth and kindness throughout the year. This initiative was made possible by the creativity and dedication of youth volunteers: Anushka, Aditya, Trisha, Saathvika, Sowmya, Anagha, Arshea, Varshaa, and Anika. Their heartfelt efforts brought comfort and connection to hundreds of seniors.

### **Kendra Scott Events**

In 2024, volunteers hosted multiple Kendra Scott fundraisers to support the Thalassemia Project, aimed at improving access to safer blood transfusions. The first fundraiser was held on February 11 at Broadway Plaza in Walnut Creek and raised **\$140**. The event brought together volunteers Trisha, Arshea, Saathvika, Lasya, and Anika, who engaged the community and shared EKAM's mission. The second fundraiser took place on June 8. Volunteers for this event included Trisha, Saathvika, Arshea, Lasya, and Anika, who worked together to raise awareness and funds for the cause.


